

COMMUNITY HEALTH GROUP FILES APPEAL TO FIGHT INEQUITABLE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES DECISION

Health Plan Known for its HighQuality Scores, Local Roots, Calls for State to Add Region's Largest Medi-Cal Plan Back to Approved List

San Diego – Community Health Group filed an official appeal yesterday with the state Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) on their decision not to award the non-profit — San Diego's largest Medi-Cal health plan — a Medi-Cal managed care plan contract in San Diego County. DHCS selected multiple contract winners yet did not pick Community Health Group, despite it being less than one point (0.93) below the next highest score.

Community Health Group already serves 36 percent of Medi-Cal managed care beneficiaries in San Diego County, the most of any health plan.

“The decision by DHCS was wrong and will decrease the quality of care available to the 330,000 San Diego-area residents we currently serve,” said Norma Diaz, CEO of Community Health Group. **“We have been flooded with an outpouring of support from health care partners and community members concerned about this inequitable and misguided decision.”**

“We are the only locally-based health plan in the region, and we are fighting to continue to provide culturally competent care to Medi-Cal members who are already negatively impacted by inequities in their community,” Diaz said.

“We achieve some of the highest quality scores both in San Diego and in California, have the highest rated provider experience among Medi-Cal managed care plans, and have 40 years of local service that demonstrate we are well-positioned to continue to serve,” Diaz said. **“We have filed our appeal and will fight to be added back as a Medi-Cal managed care plan here in San Diego.”**

- Achieving the highest score among all managed care plans in California (not just Medi-Cal managed care plans) for access to urgent and non-urgent appointments in the measurement years 2019 and 2020 California Department of Managed Health Care Timely Access Report (the most recent available data).
- In the 2021 Children Now Brief “Accountability for Medi-Cal Children’s Preventive Services: Medi-Cal Health Plans are Key to the Preventive Care Guarantee for Kids” CHG was ranked as the highest Medi-Cal Health Plan in San Diego County for delivering children’s preventive care and 10th out of 56 Medi-Cal Managed Care Plans in California.
